



### **My Voice My Choice - study of supports**

254 organizations support the My Voice My Choice initiative. We analyzed all of them and found 51 in 21 countries with interesting funding details. The others are either too small or not transparent enough. The methodology consisted in searching for information on their websites, in their annual reports and in the EU search engine. 19 receive funding from the European Union and 20 receive funding from the Open Society Foundation (see appendix). 1/5 are funded by OSF and/or EU.

The initiative is represented by Nika Kovač at the head of the Institute 8th of March. This organization has received 355,000 USD<sup>1</sup> from the Open Society Foundation between 2021 and 2023. It has also received support from the International Planned Parenthood Federation. Its European branch, the IPPF European Network, received more than 3.2 million euros from the European Union (2022-2025), 46 million dollars from the Gates Foundation (2005-2024) and almost 3 million dollars from the Open Society Foundation (2018-2023).

IPPF already has a very active lobby within national and European institutions: the European Parliamentary Forum on Population and Development (EPF), renamed EPF for Sexual and Reproductive Rights in 2022. This organization has been headed by Neil Datta since 2000. UNFPA is one of the EPF's leading funders, with more than 980,000 euros paid out in 2023.<sup>2</sup>
